T-TESS Domains 2 & 3 of the Summative Evaluation is 30% of the overall TIA score.

Growth is determined by the TEA STAAR Growth Measure/Transition Table (Domain 2A).

2023-2024 growth was measured by including ½ points and 1 points all as 1 point (a yes for growth)

2024 and beyond growth will be scored using the exact points earned on the transition table. A ½ point will equal a ½ point and 1 point will equal 1 point to create the teacher's growth percentage.

Student growth is 70% of the overall TIA score.

Growth will be measured by the ½ the Gap Model.
