


CODE OF FAIR AND HONEST PRACTICES

There are basic principles of integrity, honesty, and fair play that every candidate and political committee should follow. These principles are the foundation of our citizenry and are essential to a free and democratic society. Candidates and political committees should fully and clearly express their positions on the issues.

THEREFORE:

- (1) I will conduct the campaign openly and honestly and limit attacks on my opponent to legitimate challenges to an opponent's record and stated positions on issues.
- (2) I will not use or permit the use of innuendo or insinuation on any candidate or the candidate's personal or family life.
- (3) I will not use or permit any appeal to racism, sexism, or other prejudice based on race, religion, or national origin.
- (4) I will not use campaign material of any sort that uses conditions or conditions of employment or creating or exploiting a hostile work environment to attack the personal integrity or reputation of my opponent.
- (5) I will not use or permit any conduct or practice that tends to corrupt or undermine the integrity of free elections or that hampers or prevents the free exercise of the right of any citizen to participate in the political activity aimed at intimidating voters or causing them to refrain from voting.
- (6) I will refrain from using the name of any qualified voter to fill and any public position on any ballot proposition, and will not engage in any activity aimed at intimidating voters or causing them to refrain from voting.
- (7) I will immediately and publicly repudiate methods and tactics that may come from others that I have not authorized to use or condone. I will take any action against any subordinate who violates any law or regulation that governs elections.
